Pla de Bages: historical area that in the past had more than 27000 hectares of vineyard. Nowadays, with only 500 hectares, it has recovered its ancestral relationship with wine, after a hectic textile activity along the 20th century, taking into account that only what is linked to earth it's the real heritage of an area. Variety expression of cold weather and late ripening. Poor soils embraced by the forest that contains the smallholdings of ecological vineyard and olive trees.

Manual harvesting in boxes. Grape harvest cooled down to 4C. Manual and selection of vegetable remains to fulfill directly the 3001 barrels (of second year) without base, where it ferments. Manual pigeage with no temperature control. Pressed dry without pumps or pressing. Barrel filling in the Burgundy way. 15 months. Looking for a small size wine that let us remove the basic "noise" that comes from going through the machinery of a cellar. Allowing an aerial feeling to the wine despite the powerful expression of grape, thanks to gentleness in vineyard and cellar.
